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1. Introduction

- Blog is a online tool for communication and dissemination of Information.
- It is a websites that capture ideas, views, opinions of a users.
- It is a webpage that provides web links or comments on a specific topic either macro or micro level.

2. Kinds

- There are different kinds of Blogs:-
 1. SUBJECT BLOG: It is covered a particular subject related information. For examples education blogs, music blogs, political blogs etc.
 2. MEDIA BLOG: If it contains videos is called vlog, if it comprising links is called a linklog, a site containing a portfolio of sketches is called a sketchlog, one comprising photos is called a photolog. Blogs with shorter posts and mixed media types are called tumblelogs.

3. **DEVICE BLOG:** A blog written by a mobile device like a mobile phone is called a moblog.
4. **PERSONAL BLOG:** If it is written by individual as an ongoing diary called personal blog.
5. **CORPORATE BLOG:** If it is used for making branding or public relation purposes are called corporate blog.
