How to Reach the Venue

1. By Train: The town of Motihari has a railway station of its own, named Bapudham Motihari (station code -BMKI), with regular trains to all major destinations.
2. By Road: Buses to the town of Motihari will be available regularly from the capital city of Patna, which is 160 kilometres .
3. By Air: The nearest Airport to Motihari is Patna Airport (Lok Nayak Jai Prakash International Airport). Patna Airport is about 160 KMs far from Motihari and frequent Bus / Taxi service is available to and from the Patna AirPort.
